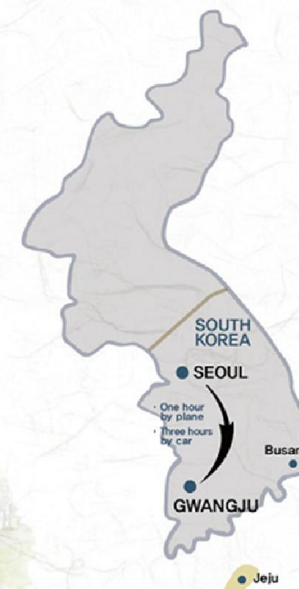


### Gwangju

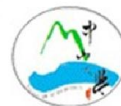
